Reaching out to a community engaged local band to start Jazz! off was our first step to bring new life to the term Jazz! Rewind became as a celebration of "rock" bands of the 1960s to the early 70s. Encompassing the very reason Jazz music was created, we are proud to bring a diverse group to the main stage.

June's Dubuque... and All That Jazz! will also feature a bean bag tournament starting at 3 p.m.. **Dubuque Farmers' Market**

The Dubuque Farmers' Market celebrated its Opening Day on Saturday, May 6, 2017, with a variety of activities available to the public, including free musical entertainment, ready to eat food vendors on site, and more, all in the area around City Hall in historic downtown Dubuque.

Early produce such as asparagus, lettuce, water cress, rhubarb, morels, and peas is available. There is also be a large selection of bedding plants, hanging baskets, house plants, freshly baked goods, and a great selection of arts and crafts--all items that make perfect gifts for Mother's Day, graduations, weddings, or a special treat for you.

The Dubuque Farmers' Market is open every Saturday from 7 a.m. - noon, May through October. Stretching from the area around City Hall at Iowa and 13th Street going down Iowa Street to 10th Street, the market has grown in recent years to attract vendors offering a larger variety of produce, meats, cheeses, baked goods, handmade goods, and on-site prepared foods.
